Big Ideas	Key observation- the child:	Outdoors	Indoors and routines	Stories, rhymes and role play
<b>Number sequence:</b> saying numbers in order to 5	<ul> <li>-Engages in counting like behaviour</li> <li>-Says some number words</li> <li>-Says numbers in the right order as high as they can (beyond 5, sometimes missing one out)</li> <li>- Forwards &amp; backwards</li> <li>- Starting from different numbers</li> </ul>	- Hide and seek	-Counting fingers and toes -Counting up and down before transitions	- 1,2,3,4,5 once I caught a fish alive
<b>Tagging one-to-one</b> : saying one number for each item	<ul> <li>Counts objects accurately, without skipping any</li> <li>Keeps track of which ones have been counted so far</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Counting steps, hops &amp; jumps rhythmically</li> <li>Explore collections, comparing amounts and counting some of the items</li> </ul>	- Counting collections	-Laying the table for the birthday party: <i>Have they</i> got one each?
<b>Cardinal counting</b> : the last number you say is the number of the group	<ul> <li>Says how many there are after counting</li> <li>Counts out a number from a larger group of objects: '<i>Give me 9</i>'</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Number hunts finding a number of things</li> <li>Tidying up: checking we have found all the 5 big balls</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Setting up, snack time, tidying up: getting the right number of things</li> <li>Counting children here today</li> </ul>	-Shop prices: paying the right number of pennies or pounds

		- Games: how many beanbags in tyre, skittles knocked down	- Collecting games with dice e.g. 10 nice things	
Recognises some numerals (number symbols)	- Says number for some numerals to 10	- Number tracks, numeral dice, numerals on trikes & containers	- Washing lines with pegged numerals	-Number picture books with numerals
