

# Activity Idea

<b>Activity</b>	Best of three
<b>Main Focus</b>	Composition

<b>Resources</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ 3 beanbags to throw in a tyre or bucket; 3 hoops to throw over a cone, 3 balls and a basketball net or football goal etc.</li> <li>➤ A method of recoding e.g. papers and pens, whiteboard and pens.</li> </ul>
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<b>Activity Outline</b>	<p>The aim of the activity is for children to split up 3 in different ways and to realise that there are still 3.</p> <p>Each child throws 3 beanbags or balls and says how many they got in or out e.g. 2 in and 1 out.</p> <p>Check there are 3 altogether, move onto the next child's turn.</p>
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<b>Extension Opportunities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Record with tallies, under in and out labels on, counting 3 altogether.</li> <li>✓ Increase the number of beanbags or balls to four.</li> </ul>
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
