



## **Activity Idea**

Activity	Builder Copier
Main Focus	Shape & spatial awareness
Resources	<ul> <li>About 10 blocks each for two children, so they have identical blocks (a varied collection e.g. six long blocks, two square, two triangular with three figures, or outdoors: 4 square blocks, I long block, I long plank, 1 short plank with 3 toy animals)</li> <li>Place mats to build on indoors, or for outside, chalk to mark a large square for each child</li> </ul>

Activity Outline	The aim of the activity is for children to build identical models, and then to use positional and shape language.
	One child is the builder and places one block at a time. Encourage the builder to say/describe what they are doing. The copier then does the same. When finished, they both go and check in order to agree that the models are the same.
	Children who are waiting for a turn can be observers who sit and check, perhaps giving advice and instruction where needed.

Extension	✓ Set up a screen or barrier, so that the builder gives instructions to the copier,
Opportunities	without seeing what they are doing.
	<ul> <li>Vary resources to include Duplo or Lego, or identical boxes and packaging</li> </ul>
