Big Ideas	Key observation- the child:	Outdoors	Indoors and routines	Stories, rhymes and role play
Comparing size, length, weight, capacity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Finds the <i>heavier</i> car goes further down the ramp - Predicts which jug <i>holds more</i> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Jumping & throwing - Sand and water play with varied containers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Playing with scales and measuring tapes 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Teddy bears picnic: finding containers for food and drink
Time sequences: ordering and predicting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sequences and predicts events, showing they are anticipating what comes <i>next</i>, or talking about <i>before, after, then</i> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Explaining games, planning events or outings: <i>first, then</i> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Ordering daily events, or creative activities e.g. cooking, printing, with pictures & words: <i>before, after</i> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Retelling or re-enacting stories and rhymes
