Big Ideas	Key observation- the child:	Outdoors	Indoors and routines	Stories, rhymes and role play
Comparing size, length, weight, capacity	 Finds the <i>heavier</i> car goes further down the ramp Predicts which jug <i>holds more</i> 	- Jumping & throwing - Sand and water play with varied containers	- Playing with scales and measuring tapes	- Teddy bears picnic: finding containers for food and drink
Time sequences: ordering and predicting	- Sequences and predicts events, showing they are anticipating what comes <i>next</i> , or talking about <i>before</i> , <i>after</i> , <i>then</i>	- Explaining games, planning events or outings: <i>first, then</i>	- Ordering daily events, or creative activities e.g. cooking, printing, with pictures & words: <i>before, after</i>	- Retelling or re- enacting stories and rhymes
