Resources

Supporting the children to act out this rhyme will provide more opportunities for them to see the directional language in context. Talk about how the children can act out up and down.

Extension opportunities

Talk to the children about their bedtime. What time do they go to bed? Talk about other times of the day, what time do they get up? Can we make a graph showing how many go to bed at 7, 8 etc? Can we make a map of everyone's day to show the sequencing of events at home?
